I am writing to respond to your February 12, 2016 letter, identified as Information Request #4 in this matter. For the reasons discussed below, our client Canaveral Port Authority (CPA) requests an extension of the deadline for responding to your request.

We recognize that the environmental review process for CPA's proposed rail extension has been temporarily suspended—at CPA's request—since November 2015. Since that time, CPA has been working to move forward with a feasibility study for a CCAFS route alternative. That study, which is now in its earliest stages, remains CPA's sole focus.

We will keep you apprised of the study's progress and, when it is complete, coordinate further on the Information Request #4. If you have any questions in the meantime, please do not hesitate to contact me.
